
Accumulating Snow Possible Friday

Wakefield,VA WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW

- Low pressure passing through North Carolina will bring a mix of rain and snow on Friday.
- A small accumulation of heavy, wet snow is expected.



TIMING/LOCATION

- Primarily Friday morning into Friday evening.
- Best chance for accumulating snow (~1") remains along/south of US 460 and along/west of I-95.
- A mix of rain and snow is possible even into Hampton Roads and northeast North Carolina as the precipitation arrives Friday morning and ends Friday night. Little to no snow accumulation expected.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- A Winter Weather Advisory is now in effect for Lunenburg and Mecklenburg County beginning 4 AM EST Friday.
- Plan on the possibility of slippery road conditions, especially within the advisory area. These hazardous conditions could impact the morning and evening commute.
- No freezing rain or ice will occur with this event.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Confidence is moderate for snow amounts and timing.
- Continue to monitor the forecast for the latest information and updates.
