# Item 1. Call to order/Determine Quorum (6:28 p.m.)

The January 28, 2021 Virtual Special meeting (Budget Work Session) of the Sussex County Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Seward.

# **Item 2. The Invocation**

No Invocation was done.

# Item 3. Agenda Amendment

There were no agenda amendments.

# Item 4. Approval of Agenda

By general consensus the agenda was approved.

#### **Item 5. Budget Discussions**

County Administrator Douglas stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss "big ticket" items, such as any new positions, capital project items, new vehicles, and or any new programs that would increase the departments' budget, etc.—with a threshold of \$5,000. This Budget Work Session was focused on departments under the County Administration umbrella. The Budget Work Session for Constitutional Officers, the Public Schools and the Department of Social Services for big ticket items will be held February 4, 2021.

The meeting is for informational purposes. No decisions and or actions will be done at this meeting.

Mr. Reid Foster, Public Safety Coordinator, stated that he had been informed that Sussex County would be receiving 500 vaccines for 1A and 1B residents for Saturday. However, he was later informed that the vaccines would not be available until the following Monday. Mr. Foster stated that the plan is to vaccine event will be the following Saturday, February 6 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Sussex Central High School.

Mr. Foster discussed the need of assistance at his office with answering phones and registering residents. He discuss the procedure of the registering process.

Supervisor Tyler volunteered the assistance of his health care staff at the Improvement Association to work the phones and help with the event.

#### Item 5a. Animal Services

Ms. Lisa Moseley, Animal Services Officer, discussed the number animals received at the Animal Shelter.

Ms. Moseley is requesting \$5,000 for the Spay/Neuter Program. This program will be free to many of the residents. There was discussion of separate line items. It was recommended to have a separate line to earmark dedicated donations.

There were requests for a tractor at an approximate cost of \$15,875 and a horse stock trailer (for seizing animals) at an approximate cost of \$14,000. There was also a request for \$22,000 to be used to convert the building in to a livestock area which will include wiring and lighting. There was a request to upgrade cat cages and condos for an estimated cost of \$6,000.

There was also a request for a position so that there will be a staff cross trained in the event the ASO was out.

# Item 5b. Housing Department

There were no big ticket item requests from the Housing Department.

County Administrator Douglas mentioned conversations with neighboring localities regarding the regional agreement regarding revenue from those agencies.

# <u>Item 5c. Planning Department</u>

Ms. Beverly Walkup, Interim Planning Director, requests two (2) big ticket items. One (1) request is for the GIS consolidation at approximately \$50,000. There are three (3) different GIS systems—Planning, Commission of the Revenue and the Sheriff's office.

The second request is for the Comp Plan amendment. The request is for \$80,000.

Mr. Douglas noted that the Community Development Department had been changed to the Planning Department. It was noted that it is listed in the budget at the Planning Department.

#### Item 5d. Public Safety

Mr. Reid Foster, Public Safety Coordinator, stated that he has three (3) big ticket items—two (2) capital projects and one (1) in the regular budget.

Mr. Foster stated that the County has signed a maintenance agreement with L3Harris Radio. A MOU is in place with the Virginia Department of Corrections to pay one half of the agreement, which is \$303,000. This payment will be in the next fiscal budget when it comes in March 2022. He stated that the County will have to pay the full amount and invoice VDOC for their half for costs.

Mr. Foster stated that one of his capital project items is the generator for the EOC at the Waverly office. There isn't an operating generator there. He got an estimate from Source Wells for a diesel generator. He has requested \$75,000 for the generator purchase.

The second capital project item requested is the Rescue Association's CIP Phase II to build two (2) fire stations over a ten (10) year period in which land will need to be purchased—with the use of engineering service. Mr. Foster stated that Stony Creek Volunteer Fire Department has been donated nine (9) acres of land.

There are two (2) options for the station in Waverly. Waverly Volunteer Rescue Squad are in the design phase of their building. He discussed purchasing at least (6) acres of land. The estimated cost will be approximately \$3 million. Mr. Foster is estimating \$250,000 to start the project.

There was general discussion of the acquisition of the land and the project costs.

#### Item 5e. Public Works

Mr. Douglas noted that Public Works is comprised of the Building Inspections Department, Building and Grounds Department, and Solid Waste Services (formerly Environmental Inspections).

#### 1. <u>Building Inspections</u>

There were no big ticket requests.

# 2. <u>Building and Grounds</u>

Mr. Jeffrey Gary, Director of Public Works, stated that there is a request for two (2) John Deere Zero turn mowers at a cost of \$20,600 for both. Other requests include paint exterior of the Social Service Building for \$6,000; repair of Maintenance Building for \$18,000; repair of the exterior of the Administration Building for \$8,500; Painting and repair of the Court Building for \$25,000; paving and sealing parking at Complex for \$45,800; a 2021 F-150 Crew Crab 4 x 4 at a cost of \$32,380; and, repair of roof and rehab windows in the old Courthouse Building at a cost of \$55,000.

#### 3. Solid Waste Services

There is a request for a Ford F350 Heavy Duty Truck at an estimated cost of \$43,635 and a 5 x 10 Dump Trailer 5,430 to use to pick up things dumped on the side of the road.

He is also requesting to purchase solid waste bulk containers to implement a new program at a cost of \$42,499.20 which includes the weekly haul fees for each site and rental fees.

Mr. Douglas stated that it was being considered to reallocate staff for litter pickup—roadside dumping and general littering.

There was discussion of a fuel tracking system.

# Item 6. Administration and Finance

Mr. Douglas discussed splitting the funding for the Deputy County Administrator position and reallocating it to other positions. There is consideration of an Economic Development (part time) position, a Human Resource (part time) position cross-trained in Payroll and Accounts Payable and a Front Desk position. Reallocating the funding would eliminate increasing the budget.

There was discussion of the county attorney's role in human resource responsibilities.

County Administrator Douglas stated that there would be no surprises of what's in the budget. Items not mentioned in these "big ticket" budget work sessions will not be added to the budget.

# 5. Appointment

# 5.01 Appointment to District 19 Community Services Board

On July 24, 2020, staff received notice of Ms. Judge's resignation from the Department of Social Services. Because Ms. Judge is not a resident of Sussex, she is no longer eligible to represent Sussex on the District 19 Community Services Board.

# 6.01 CDBG Program Administration Contract

County Administrator Douglas stated that the Request for Proposals for consulting management services for two ongoing community development projects (CDBG funded through the Virginia DHCD): the Pocahontas Neighborhood Community Improvement Project (Wakefield area), and the Waverly Tornado Recovery Urgent Needs Project were included in the packet for the Board's

review. Planning staff developed this RFP after the contract with Summit Design and Engineering Services was terminated in November 2020, due to a lack of responsiveness and a work stoppage related to a billing dispute with the County. Contracting with a new program administrator will enable the County to move forward with these two projects and complete as soon as possible. Unfortunately, staff did not receive any responses to the initial RFP in December, possibly due to timing of the holidays. As a result, the RFP has been reposted and sent directly to some interested engineering firms, with a response deadline of January 20<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Douglas noted that one (1) proposal had been received from CHA Engineering. He stated that staff is requesting that the County Administrator be authorized to negotiate the contract for consulting management services with CHA Engineering, and execute a contract, so that the projects can resume as quickly as possible.

A copy of RFP #2020-11 CDBG Project Management Services was included in the Board packet.

# 6.02. County Drug and Alcohol Policy

County Administrator Douglas stated that an amendment to the Sussex County Personnel Policy and Procedures Manual to establish a drug and alcohol policy for County employees was attached for consideration. The purpose of the policy is to promote and maintain a safe workplace free of drug and alcohol, and to establish testing criteria/procedures and disciplinary actions. Adoption of the policy will allow for testing on a random and an as needed basis ("reasonable suspicion"). After a review of several related policies from other Virginia counties and municipalities, staff modeled this policy on the one adopted by Prince George County. The County Attorney has reviewed. This policy does not apply to employees of Constitutional Officers, but they may consider similar procedures.

He noted that the policy lays out who should be tested, procedure and disciplinary action, etc. He noted that random testing would be for those employees using heavy equipment, public safety positions and or operate vehicles; it will not be for every employee.

A draft copy of the Drug and Alcohol Policy was included in the Board packet.

# 6.03 Finance Committee Recommendations

County Administrator Douglas stated that the Finance Committee met January 14, 2021 to review a number of items), including a status summary by Davenport on its financial evaluation of the County (a full report will be presented to the Board of Supervisors within the next couple months). The following are recommendations from the Finance Committee for consideration by the full Board of Supervisors:

Based on the recommendation of Davenport, approval of a master lease program for the purchase of three fire trucks for the Courthouse, Waverly, and Jarratt volunteer fire departments (\$1,797,211 to be financed over ten years), and one ambulance at for the Stony Creek Volunteer Rescue Squad (\$244,575 to be financed over seven years). Mr. Douglas stated that staff recommendation is to move forward and allow staff to execute contracts and approve purchase order for the two (2) separate contracts so that they enter in to construction/manufacturing phase of vehicle. All three (3) trucks will be constructed simultaneously and be received around the same time.

Mr. Steve White, Tie Breaker, noted that the price doesn't include all the small items to outfit, although some things can be transferred.

ON MOTION OF SUPERVISOR FLY, seconded by SUPERVISOR D. JONES and carried: RESOLVED that the Sussex County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the purchase of three (3) fire trucks at \$1,797,211(total costs) and one (1) ambulance at \$244,575.

County Administrator Douglas stated that an appropriation of \$96,027.49 from the Reserve Funds was needed to complete the final payment for a Qualified Zone Academy Bond (QZAB) for school facilities, in addition to a \$1,077,000 payment from the Escrow account.

It was noted that there were two (2) QZABs. This payment will complete one (1) bond, with the second QZAB final payment coming due November 2023, Fiscal Year 2024.

ON MOTION OF SUPERVISOR FLY, seconded by SUPERVISOR W. JONES and carried: RESOLVED that the Sussex County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the appropriation of \$96,027.49 from the Reserves to complete final payment for Qualified Zone Academy Bond (QZAB) for school facilities; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the allocation of \$1,077,000 payment from the Escrow account to satisfy the QZAB loan.

County Administrator Douglas stated that Ms. Deste Cox, Treasurer, had requested the suspension of Section 28-25 of the County code for the charge of credit/debit card fees to customers for payments through June 30, 2021. However, after speaking with the county attorney, an emergency suspension can only be done for 60 days. If credit/debit card fees to customers for payments are suspended permanently, a Public Hearing or Public Notice will have to be done which may be done at a later date.

Ms. Deste Cox explained that there is a charge for each credit/debit card transaction.

The Board agreed to not holding a Public Hearing to permanently suspend collecting debit/credit card fees. However, a Public Notice will have to be advertised for two (2) consecutive weeks.

ON MOTION OF SUPERVISOR FLY, seconded by SUPERVISOR D. JONES and carried: RESOLVED that the Sussex County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the Emergency Ordinance #2021-01 to Suspend Collection of Credit Card Fees; to-wit:

Whereas, on February 21, 2002, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 2-21-2002 (Section 28-25 of the County Code of Ordinances), which authorized the use of credit cards to pay county levies and imposed a service charge of up to four percent as authorized by Section 2.2-614.1 of the Code of Virginia; and

Whereas, during the COVID-19 Pandemic, families and business are facing increasing financial challenges as the economy continues to be negatively impacted; and

Whereas, the Board desires to suspend the credit charge service fee during this ongoing state of emergency in order to provide some relief to citizen as many struggle to meet their financial obligations; and

Whereas, pursuant to Section 15.2-1427 of the Code of Virginia, the Board may adopt an emergency ordinance without prior notice, which shall be effective for up to sixty days; and

Whereas, the Board has determined that emergency adoption of this ordinance is appropriate given the nature of the current crisis and the Board's interest in providing this relief as soon as possible.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Sussex County Board of Supervisors that the credit card service fee is hereby suspended until further action by the Board and that Section 28-25 of the County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to temporarily suspend the application of this fee.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption and shall remain in effect for 60 days unless amended or repealed by the Board before that time.

# 6.04 NG911 Funding Request

County Administrator Douglas stated that this item was added at the request of Sheriff Giles. A conference call was held with Virginia Information Technologies Agency (VITA). The County received a grant for Next Generation 911 (NG911) upgrades—changing out old technology, installing new technology. There are three (3) components to the project. One component is connectivity and installing fiber. If fiber is cut, the 911 System will not be down.

The second component is call handling—hardware and software upgrades—which are mostly being paid with grant funds but are reimbursable. The County incur costs; the State reimburses for costs.

The third component is GIS data and programs—the County has to provide for the project out of local funds. There are currently three (3) separate GIS systems—Planning, Commissioner of Revenue and the Sheriff's office (911). They are not interactive.

The GIS component will allow responses to calls more effectively. It was stated that VITA wants everything completed by next Fall.

The call handling equipment is what is to be addressed which is hardware and software. A bid has been received from Carousel, who will provide most of the upgrade work. County Administrator Douglas advised that the State has \$180,000 grant funding for this component. He stated that he doesn't have the exact cost and is expecting to have to provide local funding.

County Administrator Douglas is requesting the County to appropriate \$250,000 out of the Reserve Funds to allow the payment to Carousel and repay \$180,000 upon receipt from the State funding, to the Reserve Funds.

# 9.02 Plan for COVID-19 Vaccinations in Sussex County

Supervisor Fly stated that there has been a series of conversations with the Crater Health Department regarding there is no plan to have vaccinations for the citizens of Sussex in Sussex County. As of the day, there were no allocations for Sussex that he was aware.

Supervisor Fly provided data regarding the number of vaccinations that the citizens in Sussex had taken. Supervisor Fly stated that he and Mr. Douglas has been in contact with the Governor's office.

Supervisor Fly discussed other localities vaccinating teachers and the County hasn't vaccinated their teachers and public safety staff. Multiple businesses in the County has volunteered to use their facilities as locations for vaccinations. One (1) company in the County volunteered to buy the deep freezer to store the vaccines to keep them at the proper temperature.

Supervisor Fly stated that the County has the facilities and the ability to administer the vaccine; however, the County cannot get the Health Department to commit to providing the vaccines. He knows there is a shortage.

There was further discussion of getting citizens and the elderly population in Sussex vaccinated. Supervisor Fly wanted the public to know what's going on. He advised citizens/residents to call the elected officials and Governor's office.

County Administrator Douglas stated that he participates in weekly conference calls for county administrators and city managers in the region. Mr. Foster participates in weekly conference calls for the Health Department. Mr. Douglas stated that it was made clearly, initially, that the efforts mirrored their COVID operations which is essentially, they left Sussex and Surry counties and Hopewell, and are concentrating their efforts in Dinwiddie, Emporia, Prince George and Petersburg.

There was discussion of holding vaccinations the on school site.

Supervisor Tyler discussed conversations with Dr. Hart regarding working with Sussex's Emergency Manager.

Mr. Reid Foster, Public Safety, stated that he didn't get access until Monday. Mr. Foster stated that he was informed that people were told to register at the CDC website.

It was noted that there were software issues. There were discussions of vaccinations for 1A and 1B citizens and locations in the County.

It was noted that the Sussex Health Department was open on Wednesdays for Family Planning Services. There was discussion of when inquiring the local Health Department regarding giving the vaccinations, staff was advised that they didn't have the staff. There was discussion of possible locations and ways to vaccinate. It was noted that there was a need of at least 10 staff members along with Crater Health.

Chairman Seward stated that her instructions were to not pay anymore Crater Health District invoices until the County finds out what's going on. It was noted that the County has paid Crater Health District their first two (2) quarterly payments of \$37,079.25 each, for a total of \$74,158.50. The remaining balance the County owes Crater Health District is \$74,158.50. Chairman Seward stated that she was asking the County to freeze payment.

JONES and carried: RESOLVED that the Sussex County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the County Administrator to send a letter to Crater Health District informing that the County will be holding all payments until there is satisfactory service in Sussex County.

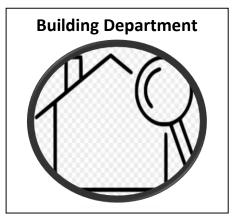

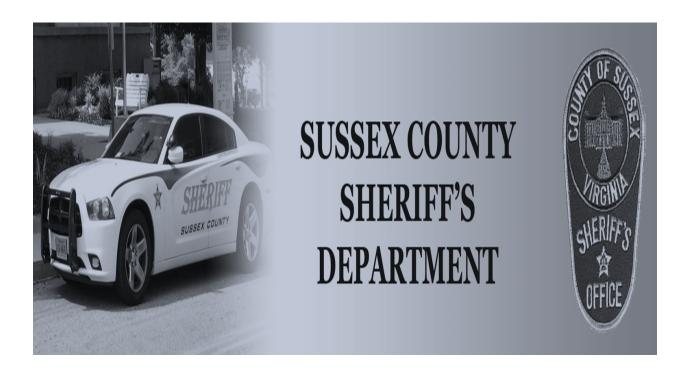

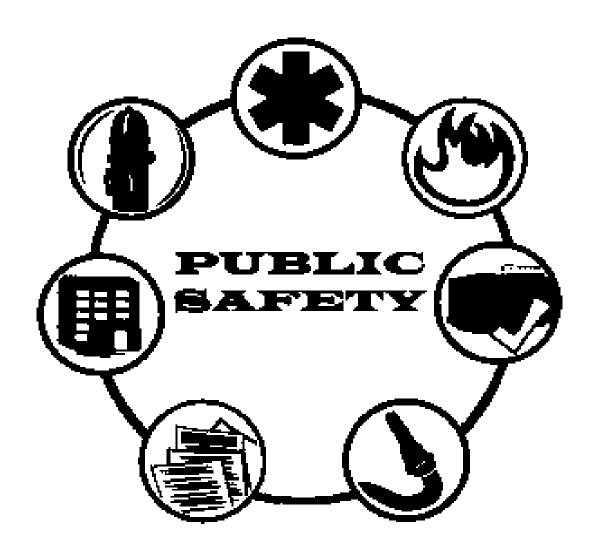

Enclosed you will find the monthly report for December 2019.

<u>RADIO SYSTEM</u>: We are continuing to push to have the recorder replaced at Courthouse. Harris is working with vendor to get something done with it. Still no resolution.

The paging system for the Fire and EMS is still not working properly. The Fire and Rescue Association is asking for resolution. I have asked Harris to replace the system as we do not have the coverage. The December meeting did not resolve any issues with paging. I will continue to put pressure on Harris to replace the system. Harris has sent tech down to do testing on system. I am requesting Harris to replace antennas on paging system due to them being directional. The Fire and Rescue Association wants resolution to this problem before the warranty runs out. They still have members whose pagers are not being activated in parts of the County.

I am working on getting quotes for remote monitoring of generators at radio sites. We still have no way of knowing when there is a power failure and if the generators are running.

<u>FIRE DEPTS</u>: Continue to apply for grants for turnout gear and equipment. Due to contract of grant writer not being renewed, we can't apply for AFG grant. Also, still doesn't have log in for FEMA Go.

Engine 110 Foam System has been repaired. Waiting on repair bill.

Engine 410 Foam System was repaired, waiting on bill.

SCBA testing is scheduled for end of February. Must do this to keep in NFPA compliance and to keep our 10 year warranty.

Breathing Air compressors are scheduled for February testing along with air test.

Getting quotes for hose and ladder testing to stay in NFPA compliance

Need 4 sets of Tires for trucks. Will be talking with County Administration about getting money for these. Cost is averaging \$4,000.00 per truck.

Sussex County fire depts. responded to 564 calls in 2019.

**RESCUE**: New Hear radios for Waverly have been installed and working.

Still working with both squads to resolve issues with Lifestar.

Would like to put RFP out for contracted EMS service.

Total rescue call for both squads for 2019 was 1823.

<u>EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT</u>: I have started purchasing equipment for EOC. Have submitted paperwork to receive the \$7,500.00 grant funds.

# BY-LAWS OF THE BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS SUSSEX COUNTY, VIRGINIA

#### ARTICLE I. MEMBERSHIP

- 1-1. The Sussex County Board of Zoning Appeals, hereafter referred to as the "Board", shall be appointed by the Sussex County Circuit Court and each member shall be sworn in by the Clerk of the Circuit Court prior to assuming his or her duties.
- 1-2. The Board shall consist of five (5) members. One of the five members may be a member of the Planning Commission. Members of the Board shall hold no other public office in the County.
- 1-3. The term of each regular member shall be five (5) years.
- 1-4. A member whose term expires shall continue to serve until his or her successor is qualified and appointed to serve on the Board of Zoning Appeals.
- 1-5. Any member of the Board shall be eligible for reappointment.

### **ARTICLE II. OFFICERS**

- 2-1. The Board shall organize and elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman as officers annually in the month of January for a one (1) year term. The officers may be re-elected to successive terms.
- 2-2. The Chairman shall preside at all meetings and hearings of the Board, shall decide all points of order and procedures and shall appoint any committees that may be found necessary.
- 2-3. The Vice-Chairman shall assume the duties of Chairman in the Chairman's absence.
- 2-4. The Zoning Administrator of Sussex County or his/her duly assigned agent shall, (1) serve as the Secretary to the Board and shall handle all the official correspondence subject to these rules at the direction of the Board; (2) send out all public notices required by the rules of procedures; (3) keep minutes of the Board's proceedings; (4) notify members of all meetings; and (5) keep a file on each case that comes before the Board.

### **ARTICLE III. MEETINGS**

- 3-1. Meetings of the Board shall be scheduled by the Chairman in coordination with the Secretary. Meetings shall begin at 6:00 p.m.
- 3-2. A quorum shall consist of three (3) Board members.

- 3-3. The Board may adjourn a meeting to another certain date and time if all cases/applications/appeals cannot be disposed of on the day set, and no further public notice shall be necessary for such a meeting.
- 3-4. A meeting shall be cancelled due to inclement weather if the County is closed on the day of the meeting. The meeting will be rescheduled for another date by the Chairman in coordination with the Secretary following the public notice guidelines under Article IV.

### ARTICLE IV. PROCUEDURES FOR HEARING BOARD CASES

- 4-1. Appeals to the Board may be taken by any person aggrieved of by any officer, department, board, or bureau of the County affected by a decision of the Zoning Administrator; or from any order, requirement, decision or determination made by any other administrative officer in the enforcement of the Zoning Ordinance.
- 4-2. The applicant shall provide the Zoning Administrator with all the information requested on the application form prescribed by the Board and any such additional information and data as may be required to advise the Board fully with reference to the application for an appeal or variance request, whether such information is called for by the official application form or not. No application for an appeal or variance will be considered by the Board unless it is made on the application required and the appropriate application fees have been paid.
- 4-3. An application for an appeal or variance filed according to the above procedure shall be given a case number within five (5) days of the date filed. Application for an appeal or variance will be assigned for a hearing in the order in which they are received.
- 4-4. The Secretary of the Board shall notify the parties of interests (applicant, adjacent landowners, etc.) of the date and time for the public hearing of the case and give public notice in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 15.2-2204, the Code of Virginia (1950, as amended).
- 4-5. At the time of the public hearing, the applicant may appear on behalf of the application or be represented by counsel or an agent. The Zoning Administrator's statement shall be made first, followed by the applicant's statement and then comments from any private citizen or business owner for or against the request. The Administrator shall be given the opportunity for a final rebuttal.
- 4-6. A final decision of any application for an appeal or variance to the Board must be approved by a quorum of the membership of the Board. The decision may be delayed so to allow Board members additional time to consider the evidence presented or to allow any additional material to be submitted as requested by the Board prior to rendering a decision.
  - No member of the Board may act upon any case with respect to property in which the member has an interest. In such cases the member must declare their conflict of interest and abstain from voting.
- 4-7. Within fifteen (15) days after the public hearing, the Secretary on behalf of the Board shall notify the applicant and any other interested party in writing of the final decision of the Board.

### **ARTICLE V. BOARD RECORDS**

- 5-1. A file of all materials and decisions relating to each case shall be kept by the Secretary as part of the records of the Board.
- 5-2. All records of the Board shall be public record in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act.

### **ARTICLE VI. AMENDMENTS**

6-1. These By-Laws may be amended, revised or repealed by a majority vote of the Board.

### **ARTICLE VII. ENACTMENT**

7-1. These By-Laws shall replace all others and are adopted effective this <u>22nd</u> day of <u>October</u>, 2014.

### **BY-LAWS**

### OF

## THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF SUSSEX COUNTY, VIRGINIA

#### **ARTICLE I**

### Name, Purpose and Powers

**Section 101**: The name of this body shall be the Industrial Development Authority of Sussex County, Virginia (the "Authority").

**Section 102**: The "Authority", shall fulfill all the purposes and intents of the General Assembly of Virginia, as expressed in Title 15.2, Chapter 49, of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended (the "Code of Virginia"), and by any enactment, to promote industry and develop trade in the County of Sussex, Virginia (the "County") and the Commonwealth of Virginia (the "Commonwealth") for the benefit of the County and the Commonwealth.

**Section 103**: The Authority shall have any and all powers that have been granted to it by Title 15.2, Chapter 49, of the Code of Virginia (the "IDA Act"), that may be granted to it by any other enactment of the General Assembly, and that may be granted to it by any delegation of authority from the Board of Supervisors of Sussex County, Virginia (the "Board of Supervisors").

#### **ARTICLE II**

### **Offices**

Section 201: The principal office of the Authority shall be located in the County.

**Section 202**: Except as otherwise required by resolution of the Authority, or as the business of the Authority may require, all of the books and records of the Authority shall be kept at the Authority's office. The minutes of the meetings of the Authority shall be open to the public as provided by law.

#### ARTICLE III

### Commission

**Section 301**: The Authority shall be governed by a Board of Directors composed of seven (7) Directors, appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Sussex County, Virginia. Appointments shall be for terms of four (4) years.

**Section 302**: Except as otherwise provided by law, all powers and duties of the Authority shall be exercised and performed by the Board of Directors, acting by majority vote of those Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present.

### **ARTICLE IV**

### **Directors**

**Section 401**: Each Director shall, upon appointment or reappointment, before entering on their duties, take and subscribe the oath prescribed by Section 49-1 of the Code of Virginia, which reads as follows: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and that I will faithfully and impartially discharge all duties incumbent on me as a Director of the Industrial Development Authority of Sussex County, Virginia, according to the best of my ability, (so help me God)."

**Section 402**: The oath shall be administered by the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Sussex County, Virginia.

#### **ARTICLE V**

### <u>Officers</u>

**Section 501**: The Directors shall elect from their membership a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman, and from their membership or not, as they desire, a Secretary and Treasurer, or a Secretary-Treasurer, and Assistant Secretary.

**Section 502**: Officers shall be elected annually at the first regular meeting of the calendar year and shall commence their duties immediately upon election and shall continue in office thereafter until a successor shall have been elected and qualified.

**Section 503**: The duties of the Chairman shall be as follows: to preside at meetings of the Board of Directors; to call special meetings; to call special elections; to be an ex officio member of all committees; to sign, with the Secretary or any other Officer of the Authority duly authorized by the Board of Directors, any documents or instruments which the Board of Directors has authorized or directed to be executed, except in cases where the execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Board of Directors or by these By-Laws to some other Officer of the Board of Directors, or shall be required by law to be otherwise signed or executed; and in general perform all duties incident to the office of Chairman and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors from time to time. The Chairman shall have an equal vote with the other Directors, and shall have a second tie-breaking vote on any question.

**Section 504**: The duties of the Vice-Chairman shall be as follows: to preside at meetings at the request of or in the absence of the Chairman. In case of death or resignation of the Chairman the

Vice-Chairman shall become Chairman for the remainder of the term for which the Chairman was elected. When acting at the request of or in the absence of the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the Chairman. The Vice-Chairman shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Board of Directors from time to time.

**Section 505**: The duties of the Secretary shall be as follows: to cause the preparation of the minutes of meetings of the Board of Directors, which shall be kept in a record book and made available for public inspection as provided by law; to have custody of all important records of the Authority; to cause the seal of the Authority to be affixed to all documents or instruments, the execution of which on behalf of the Authority under its seal is duly authorized or directed by the Board of Directors; to sign with the Chairman or Vice-Chairman any documents or instruments which the Board of Directors has authorized or directed to be executed; to cause all notices to be duly given as required by law, these By-Laws, or by the Board of Directors; to call meetings of the Board of Directors to order in the absence of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman and thereupon to conduct an election for a temporary presiding Officer for that meeting; and in general to perform all the duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the Board of Directors.

**Section 506**: The Assistant Secretary shall perform the duties of the Secretary at his/her request or in his/her absence. When acting at the request or in the absence of the Secretary, the Assistant Secretary shall have all the powers of and be subject to all restrictions upon the Secretary. The Assistant Secretary shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Board of Directors from time to time.

**Section 507**: The duties of the Treasurer shall be as follows: to work with the County Treasurer whom shall receive, keep and track all IDA Funds, to keep or cause to be kept suitable records of all financial transactions of the Authority; to have such records audited annually through the County of Sussex and to furnish a copy of such audit to the Board of Supervisors; to make available for public inspection each such annual audit; to provide reports of funds through the County Treasurer whom have charge and custody of all funds and be responsible for their investment and deposit in the name of the Authority when approved, recommended and authorized by the Board of Directors; and in general to perform all the duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall give bond in such sum as may be fixed by the Board of Directors with surety to be approved by the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE VI**

### Meetings

**Section 601**: Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at 2:00 p.m. on the second Wednesday of each calendar quarter (March, June, September, December) month in the School

Board Meeting Room 21356 Sussex Drive, Waverly Virginia 23890, unless otherwise determined by a majority vote of the Board's membership. Staff shall give the Board ten (10) days' notice of the need to schedule a meeting.

- a) The Sussex County Industrial Authority Board of Directors may, in a regularly scheduled meeting, by a majority vote of all present, modify or change meeting times and/or dates as determined necessary or in the best interest of the Sussex County IDA.
- b) The Board of Directors may from time to time wish or need to meet in locations other than the County Administration Conference room. Such meeting locations (times and dates) must be identified and made at a regularly scheduled meeting by a majority vote of those present.
- c) All changes must be identified and recorded in the official minutes of the Sussex County Industrial Authority.

**Section 602**: Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by or at the request of the Chairman or any two (2) Directors. Whenever any two (2) Directors, not including the Chairman, request a special meeting, they shall provide the Secretary with a statement of the business to be considered for the purpose of providing adequate notice.

**Section 603**: Notice of any special meeting shall be given at least three (3) days in advance and in writing, stating the business to be considered, delivered personally or mailed to each Director at their business or home address at whichever is most likely to be received. If mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the United States mail so addressed, with postage prepaid. Any Director may waive notice of any meeting. The attendance of a Director at a meeting shall constitute waiver of notice of such meeting, except as otherwise provided by law.

**Section 604**: Four (4) members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum of the Board for the purposes of conducting its business and exercising its power and for all other purposes, except that no facilities owned by the Authority shall be leased, or disposed of in any manner without a majority vote of all the members of the Board of Directors, and except as otherwise provided by law.

**Section 605**: Except as otherwise required in these By-Laws or by the Act, voting shall be by simple majority of those present at any duly constituted meeting of the Board of Directors.

**Section 606**: No Director shall be allowed to vote by proxy at any meeting of the Authority.

**Section 607**: At all meetings of the Authority the following order of business shall be observed, as far as consistent with the purpose of the meeting:

1) Call to Order

- 2) Approval of Agenda
- 3) Proof of Notice of Meeting
- 4) Reading and approval of the minutes of the preceding meeting or meetings
- 5) Public hearings and consideration of resolutions or other matters involving proposed financings
- Reports of Officers
  - a. Treasurer's Report
  - b. Chairman's Report
- 7) Reports of Committees
- 8) Public Comments
- 9) Old Business
- 10) New Business
- 11) Adjournment

**Section 608**: The vote of the adoption of every resolution, any proposal creating a liability, or for the appropriation or expenditure of funds shall be by yeas or nays, and whenever the vote is not unanimous, the names of members voting for and against shall be entered upon the minutes of the meeting.

**Section 609**: Except as otherwise provided in the By-Laws, procedure at meetings shall follow Robert's Rules of Order.

**Section 610**: The Board of Directors may adopt, amend and alter from time to time such rules, regulations, or forms which it may deem necessary or expedient for the management of the affairs of the Authority and which shall not be inconsistent with the Act. The Secretary of the Authority shall maintain current copies of all rules, regulations, and forms adopted by the Authority, which shall be available for public inspection at all times at the office of the Industrial Development Authority.

**Section 611**: When approved, all minutes shall be signed by the Secretary and the presiding Officer of the particular meeting.

### **ARTICLE VII**

### **Committees**

**Section 701**: The Chairman may, with advice and consent of the Board of Directors, appoint such special committees as may be deemed appropriate to carry out the intent and purpose of the Authority.

Executive Committee: The Board of Directors may designate, by resolution adopted by a majority of the Directors, any two or more of the Directors to constitute an Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall consider on behalf of the Board of Directors, all matters brought to its attention when the Board of Directors is not in session during either a regular or a special meeting. The Executive Committee may act solely in an advisory capacity and shall not exercise any of the powers granted to the Authority or its Officers pursuant to these By-Laws or the Act. The Executive Committee shall report to the members of the Authority at the Authority's next regularly scheduled meeting all matters discussed by the Executive Committee.

Industrial Advisory Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint an Industrial Advisory Committee to advise the Authority from time to time upon general or specific matters which may come before the Board of Directors. The Industrial Advisory Committee shall consist of any number of persons as the Board of Directors deem advisable and its members shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors. Members of the Industrial Advisory Committee may attend all regular meetings of the Board of Directors. Members of the Industrial Advisory Committee shall not receive any compensation for their services but may be reimbursed for necessary traveling and other expenses incurred while on the business of the Authority. The actions of the Advisory Committee shall in no way bind the members of the Board of Directors of the Authority.

Special Committees: The Board of Directors may appoint from time to time such other committees as it may deem to be necessary and expedient to promote the purposes of the Authority. Such committees shall be advisory only and shall not be empowered to act by or on behalf of the Authority. Members of any special committee shall not be compensated for their services but may be reimbursed for necessary traveling and other expenses incurred while on the business of the Authority.

#### **ARTICLE VIII**

### **Legal Counsel**

**Section 801**: The Authority may engage legal counsel to advise and represent it in all legal matters and proceedings and to act as counsel to the Authority on matters within its jurisdiction.

#### **ARTICLE IX**

### Staff

**Section 901**: The Board of Directors may employ and pay compensation to such employees and agents as the Board of Directors shall deem necessary in carrying out the business of the Authority.

### **ARTICLE X**

### Official Seal

**Section 1001**: The official Seal of the Authority shall consist of a flat-faced circular die with the name of the Authority engraved thereon.

Section 1002: The Seal of the Authority shall be kept by the Secretary of the Authority.

### **ARTICLE XI**

### Fiscal Year

**Section 1101**: The fiscal year of the Industrial Development Authority of Sussex County, Virginia, shall be from July 1 until June 30 of the following year.

#### **ARTICLE XII**

### Compensation for Board of Directors

**Section 1201**: The Directors shall receive no salary but may be compensated such an amount per meeting as may be approved by the Board of Supervisors, not to exceed the maximum amount permitted by the IDA Act and shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling and other expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

#### ARTICLE XIII

### **Amendments**

**Section 1301**: Except as otherwise provided by law, these By-Laws may be amended, added to, altered or repealed in whole or in part by the Board of Directors at any meeting of the Board of Directors, provided that notice of the proposed amendment, addition, alteration, or repeal is given in the notice of such meeting, and such notice is delivered as provided in ARTICLE VI, Section 603, at least one week in advance. Any Director may waive written notice.

### INTRODUCTION

Sussex County has many assets for economic development. It has easy access to both the Richmond and Norfolk metro areas, both of which are growing in the direction of Sussex County. But it offers lower capital and operating costs, a less congested setting with better availability of land for new facilities, and other competitive advantages. Its highway and rail lines provide great connections to major growing markets, ports, and other features eagerly sought by new and expanding business facilities. Major investments have been made in Sussex County to prepare developable land, expand infrastructure, and provide other services and amenities for expanding the local economy. Virginia's overall business climate is excellent in many ratings (for example, CNBC: https://www.cnbc.com/2019/07/09/virginia-is-americas-top-state-for-business-in-2019.html).

Despite these many advantages, however, the Sussex County economy remains underdeveloped. For the 3,600 county residents who are employed, it offers only about 1,900 private sector jobs, so many must commute out to work. Nearly 23% of residents have incomes below the poverty level. Recent population trends are downward, suggesting that the county's best and brightest may be migrating out.

Shortcomings in the performance of the Sussex County business economy are clearly a leading cause of these problems. Nearly 40% of private sector jobs in the county are in businesses whose average pay is well below that considered necessary for a living wage such as Accommodation and Food Services (local average annual pay of \$14,795). Sussex County does have some businesses that do pay well, such as Wholesale Trade (\$52,398 per year) but they have not been effectively recruited and nurtured here and remain undersized.

The Sussex County Board of Supervisors is alert to these issues and has made economic development a high priority.

Bruce Facility Planning Consultants, LLC, is a consulting firm with deep Virginia experience. Its primary service is assisting companies to identify the optimal location for new and expanding facilities. In this role, the BFPC Team brought new facilities, jobs, and investments to Virginia by major corporations such as AT&T, and assisted in expansion of existing Virginia facilities such as the Volvo New River Valley Plant, now the world's largest Volvo truck assembly works.

BFPC also use its capabilities in a "mirror image" manner, counseling states and communities about preparing for and promoting development. In this role, it has conducted numerous projects in Virginia for state agencies (the Virginia Tobacco Commission), regional organizations (Virginia's First Regional Industrial Facility Authority), and counties (Amelia, Halifax, Pittsylvania).

BFPC proposes to assist Sussex County with this vital goal by providing counsel on economic development as described on the following pages.



### **SERVICES**

Bruce Facility Planning Consultants, LLC, proposes to provide Sussex County with a series of tailored economic development services which it believes will offer the best opportunities for optimal near-term and long-range growth.

### **Action 1: Review of Industrial Sites**

**Rationale**. BFPC recommends beginning its consultation with this vital step for the following reasons:

- Site availability may be one of Sussex County's most prominent and attractive economic development assets. For example, in a consulting assignment from the Virginia Tobacco Commission, BFPC identified a site in Sussex County as the most promising of 19 located throughout VTC territory. Even taking into account the economic effects of the current pandemic, many sectors of US industry are growing and seeking sites. Sussex County has wisely begun the site development process but needs to move ahead, develop appropriate data on its sites, undertake selected improvements, and present information to prospective new companies.
- Sussex County and its partners have invested extensively in acquiring and preparing industrial land. The county has purchased about 1,130 acres in the Highway 460 Corridor, an adjacent 702 acres are also available, and other properties are in the planning stage. It is essential to build on this first step and achieve a return on the County's investment.
- Much work has already been done related to some sites, which achieved up
  to Tier 4 in the Virginia Economic Development Partnership's site certification
  program. BFPC can add much value by assisting in the consolidation of
  existing data, identification of areas in need of further study, and presentation
  of findings in a format effective and compelling to prospective users.
- Thorough knowledge of community site characteristics should be a key input to further work (such as identification of specific industries for a targeted recruitment campaign) that BFPC may conduct if Sussex County so wishes.
- BFPC's knowledge of how expanding companies select sites for new facilities and investments and its staff's experience as site selection consultant to over \$125 billion of new capital investment is particularly relevant to this service.



**Overview of Services**. BFPC will receive data developed by Sussex County and its economic development allies and collaborators on existing and proposed industrial sites and properties, review the information in accord with standards to be developed, identify data gaps, recommend additional actions, and offer limited initial comments on presenting promotional information to prospective investors.

Sussex County will provide BFPC with all existing studies, investigations, and data related to current and possible new industrial sites in the County. Work done via the Site Certification Program of the Virginia Economic Development Partnership is especially important. Sites expected to be studied are:

- Cabin Point Road Site,
- Henry Road Site,
- Henry Technology Commerce Center, and
- Sussex County "Megasite."

BFPC will also be alert for land not currently being marketed that might be developed into new sites for manufacturing, logistical, and other industrial facilities.

Action 1 will be a limited, focused, first-step summary of industrial site conditions in Sussex County. Its goal is to provide County leadership with a general understanding from a professional site selection consultant's view of the County's ability to offer siting options to new and expanding industrial prospects. BFPC's research at this time will consist solely of reviewing data produced by others and will not include any surveys, engineering, site inspections, or other original investigations or interpretations. Action 1 is to offer an initial overview of one critical element of Sussex County's economic development readiness but not provide a comprehensive program. Work proposed at this time will not include actual production of plans, strategies, or materials, although certain work of that type may be conducted in subsequent assignments from Sussex County to BFPC if mutually agreed upon.

### **<u>Deliverables</u>**. BFPC's deliverables for Action 1 will consist of the following:

Site Data Template. BFPC will propose a list of data (such as surveys and availability of utilities at industrial levels), technical studies (such as Environmental Site Assessments and Wetlands Delineations) and other data and standards that should be available on industrial sites. The list will be refined in collaboration with Sussex County and its economic development allies and will build upon work already conducted by the County and its affiliates such as the Virginia Economic Development Partnership Site Certification Program. The anticipated result will be a reasonable, businesslike set of standards for data that should be gathered and assembled for each site in Sussex County likely to be marketed to industrial prospects.



- Review of Existing Sites in Accord with Template. Upon agreement with Sussex County on the template, BFPC will conduct a review based upon the template of data provided on existing sites in Sussex County including the four listed above and possibly additional sites that may be identified during the consulting project.
- Overall High-Level Assessment of Site Inventory. BFPC will provide a high-level assessment of the entire set of sites in Sussex County. The overall inventory will be considered with regard to conditions such as:
  - ➤ The level of completeness of the current site inventory. Is there a need for additional or different sites to attract promising business activities to Sussex County?
  - Competitiveness. Does the existing inventory represent a reasonably broad set of site options to prospects likely to consider the County as the location for a new or expanded industrial facility?
  - Potential of existing sites to attract facilities that will serve the particular needs of Sussex County. For example, can the sites help attract industrial sectors that pay more than the County's relatively low current average pay?

Action 1 will be a limited, focused, first-step summary of selected industrial site conditions in Sussex County. Its goal with be to provide the County's leadership with a general initial understanding from a professional site selection consultant's perspective of the community's ability to offer siting options to new/expanding industrial prospects.

BFPC's research at this time will consist solely of reviewing data produced by other parties and will not include any surveys, engineering, site inspections, or other original investigations or interpretations. Findings of Action 1 are expected to address this one critical element of Sussex County's economic development readiness but not a comprehensive program. Work proposed at this time will not include actual production of plans, strategies, or materials although certain work of that type may be conducted in subsequent assignments from Sussex County to BFPC if mutually agreed upon.



### **Actions 2 and Beyond: Additional Economic Services**

BFPC envisions its services to Sussex County as an ongoing, logical, integrated series of individual assignments, carefully tailored to the county's unique needs and other conditions. Following completion of the Action 1 work on industrial sites, Sussex County and BFPC may work together to define possible additional consultation. Examples of studies not included now but possibly in the future:

**Human Resources**. In-depth investigation of types of personnel recruitable by industrial facilities locating and expanding in Sussex County. Initial data scans suggest a favorable labor market with a supply of local workers (probably including high-skill residents who must now commute to jobs outside the County but would be open to taking appropriate new positions closer to home); a living environment supportive of recruitment and transfer of specialist, managerial, and professional staff; and other human resource assets desired by new industrial facilities. Confirming these conditions can support a compelling business case for companies to locate their facilities in Sussex County.

### <u>Identification of Specific Target Industries and Companies</u>.

Recruitment of new facilities is most effective and beneficial when a community pursues the types of business and industrial activities that best serve its own needs, and also concentrates its outreach efforts on businesses with a real need for the community's assets. Solid research allows a focused, efficient, persuasive "rifle" approach rather than a broad, scattered, vague "shotgun" approach. It guides crafting of marketing plans and materials to hit prospects' "hot buttons" and show them how Sussex County can help address their urgent issues. BFPC can provide Sussex County with a customized list of industries, refine the list further to specific companies and executives within those industries, and recommend ways to catch their attention.

Marketing Strategy and Action Plan. Marketing communities to potential investors is a highly specialized activity, quite different from selling to a mass audience. There are far fewer promising prospects; but the value and economic impacts of those prospects' decisions can be many tens of millions of dollars. This small but precious pool of candidates must be handled in a tailored, custo-mized manner. Many economic development marketing campaigns miss this point and thus fall short of goals. A clear, disciplined, detail-oriented marketing plan can lead to optimal use of Sussex County resources and the greatest potential for success.

Industry-Specific Marketing Studies. In line with the need cited above for focused outreach to specific, thoughtfully selected sectors, BFPC can craft studies that make a compelling business case why Sussex County is particularly attractive to selected types of industry. This is best illustrated by the attached study written for the Casper (Wyoming) Area Economic Development Alliance.



### PROJECT MANAGEMENT

### **Compensation**

BFPC is prepared to commit to provide its Action 1 services as described above for the fee of nine thousand eight hundred dollars (\$9,800). Reports and correspondence will be in electronic form to avoid printing and shipping costs. Any costs to BFPC not specified herein will be reimbursed by Sussex County.

### **Contract and Schedule**

This assignment will be governed by a contract to be executed between Sussex County and BFPC. The agreement will address details of the consulting project including schedule. No statement by either party is binding until such contract is duly executed by both.

### **Need for Support from Sussex County**

BFPC expects support from Sussex County in providing data and materials such as previous studies and reports; assuring that BFPC receives all materials from all relevant parties and sources; arranging for BFPC's teleconferences and other communications with economic development allies, public officials, businesses, and other participants; promptly reviewing and commenting on draft reports and other materials submitted by BFPC; and providing overall guidance to assure the best results.
