- After public comment and discussion, Mr. Peschke moved that the General Registrar's office be open on one Sunday during the 2021 statewide election cycle, October 17, 2021, from 1:00 until 5:00 p.m., for voting. The motion was seconded and passed with two in favor and one opposing.
