T. Robertson Blount, Director of Finance, gave an update on changes to the Sussex County FY16 Budget since the previous Budget Work Session. The changes are:

- 1. Notice to Receive from Waverly Rescue Revenue Sharing Contribution in the amount of \$130,000.00 for FY2016. This amount represents 40% of the estimated annual net income. In the previous proposed budget, the budget was anticipated a revenue of \$200,000.00.
- 2. A two percent (2%) salary adjustment was included in the previous proposed budget, awarded by the Commonwealth of Virginia for employees of the Department of Social Services. Subsequent to the previous presentation, notice has been received from the State that all Constitutional Officers and their staff are anticipated to be granted a two percent (2%) increase effective September 1, 2015. These salaries adjustments are reimbursed by the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 3. A two percent (2%) increase was included for local county employees effective September 1, 2015 and Board members effective January 1, 2016.
