Did owners pick up the dog animal control picked up at the car accident?	PER MR. EDDIE VICK <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Since the weather has cooled off, a time will be scheduled in the near future to get the old shelter torn down using inmate labor. Waste Management will provide the boxes and take the construction debris to the landfill. • In July 2016, only one animal was euthanized (canine) due to its medical condition after being evaluated by the veterinarian. • Euthanized by veterinarian, we do not euthanize except it rare /special cases in the field • Animal Services did not pick up an animal from an accident in July 2016. However, if this occurrence did arise, the animal would be picked up by the owner after being released from the medical facility.
