a.	Conditional Rezoning Application #2012-01, Willow Woods, LLC, applicant: (Tabled from June 21, 2012 public hearing meeting). The applicant seeks to rezone approximately 146.79 acres, part of tax map number 13-(A)-5 from A-1, General Agricultural District and B-2, General Business District to Planned Unit Development (PUD). Consistent with the Comprehensive Plan's future land use designation the rezoning of the aforementioned property will allow for the construction of a mixed use development, consisting of approximately 175 single-family units, 296 multi-family units, 400 senior housing units, recreational amenities, commercial development, and a fire station, which are to be completed in (4) phases over a (20) year period. The applicant has voluntarily proffered several conditions to be attached to the zoning request, if approved. The property in question is located at the intersection of Route 602 (Cabin Point Road) and Route 625 (Newville Road) in the Courthouse Election District.
