Whereas, the Virginia Department of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region III officials have reviewed the "2022 Richmond-Crater Multi-Region Hazard Mitigation Plan" and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governments and entities;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sussex, Virginia adopts the "2022 Richmond-Crater Multi-Region Hazard Mitigation Plan" as an official plan; and

Be it further resolved, the County of Sussex will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Virginia Department of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region III officials to enable the Plan's final approval.
